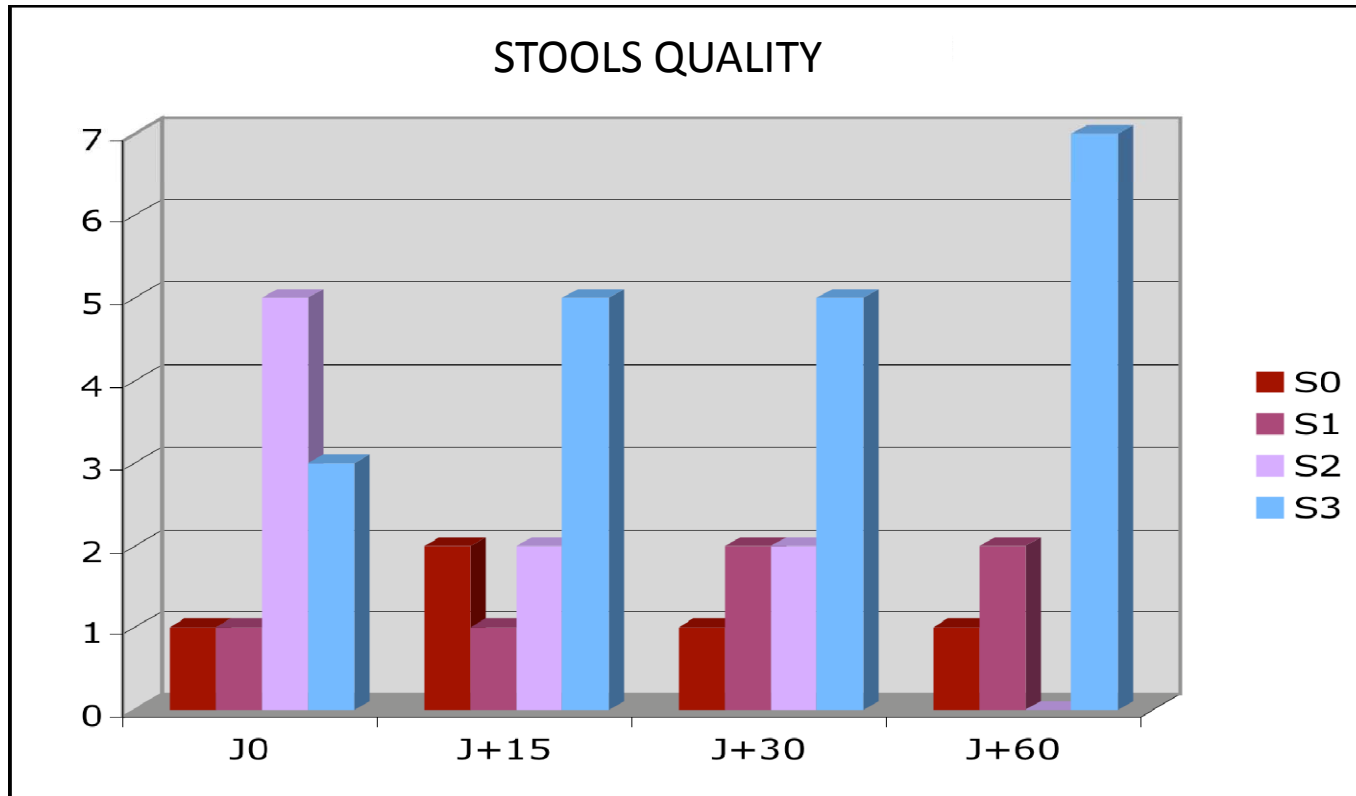


CHRONIC ULCERATIVE COLITIS

EVALUATION CRITERIA: SCORE OF UC-DAI



Stools become normal for 70% of the cases.

S0 : Frequent and bloody stools (6 per day)

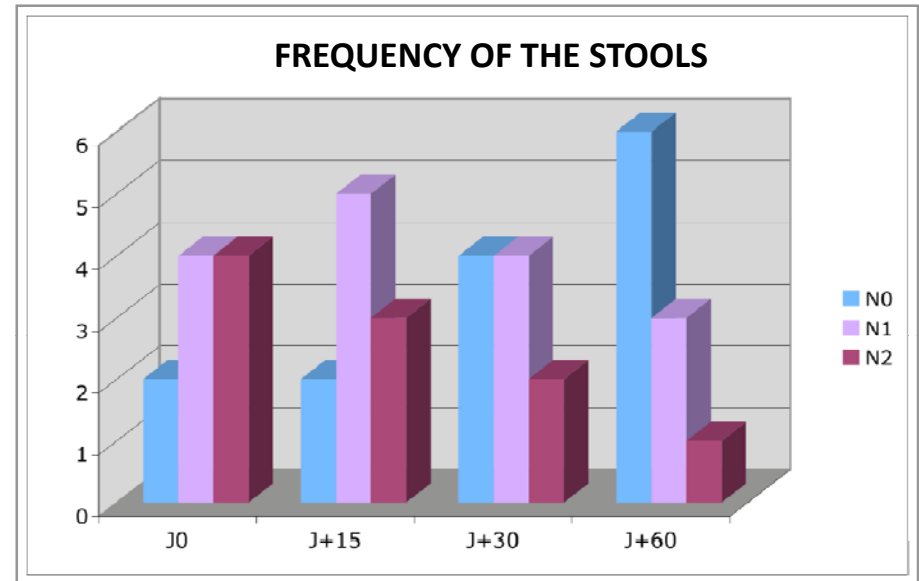
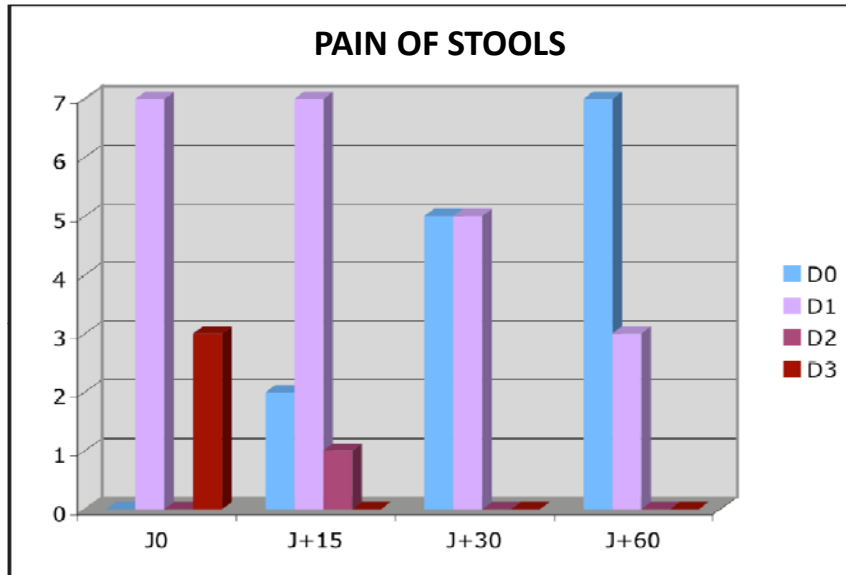
S1 : Stools with bloody traces and around 4 times per day

S2 : Stools with bloody traces and around twice a day

S3 : Normal stools

CHRONIC ULCERATIVE COLITIS

EVALUATION CRITERIA: SCORE OF UC-DAI



NO MORE PAIN IN 70% OF THE CASES

2 people showing severe pain are relieved after 15 days

D0 : No pain

D1 : Light pain

D2 : Severe pain, hard to stand it.

D3 : Major pain, drugs are required

THE TRANSIT BECOMES NORMAL IN 60% OF THE CASES

N0 : normal frequency of going for stools

N1 : more than twice per day

N2 : more than 4 per day
